

IT'S THE RULE

- Green rollout carts are for your convenience. Please remember to roll them out by 7 AM and in by midnight on collection day.
- Blue bins are for recyclables and should be stored inside. For collection, place at the curb.
- Bag or box your lawn clippings.
- Tree limbs should be placed separately on the curb for pick-up.
- Carpet and building supplies should not be placed on the curb. Disposal is by owner.
- Keep your porches clean and don't use them for storage. Indoor furniture outside is prohibited.



IT'S A FACT

- Only 33% of households in Salisbury currently recycle. Recycling helps the environment and saves space in the landfill.
- 9 full time and 1 part time city employees collect garbage and trash from 11,262 households.
- Approximately 1,660 nuisance notices are sent each year.
- The city maintains many sites including 7 cemeteries, 18 parks and the greenway.



IT'S THE LAW

- Littering is illegal and can bring fines up to \$500.
- Drinking alcoholic beverages or selling illegal drugs on city property (including sidewalks) is punishable by arrest and/or fines.
- Overgrown yards will be mowed by the city and owners billed if official notification is ignored.
- Loud noise and music from a vehicle or a site is a nuisance if you can hear it over 50 feet away.
- Junked cars without current tags and registration will be towed by the city if owners do not respond to official notification.
- No parking in front yards except on prepared surfaces.

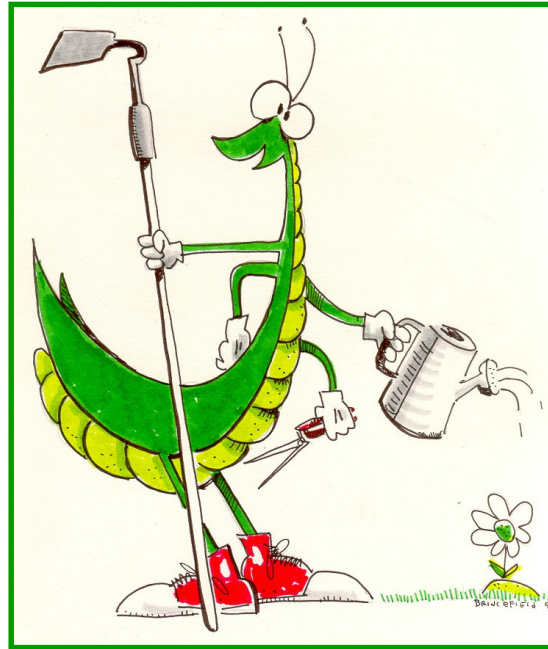
